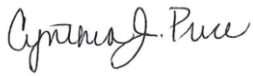

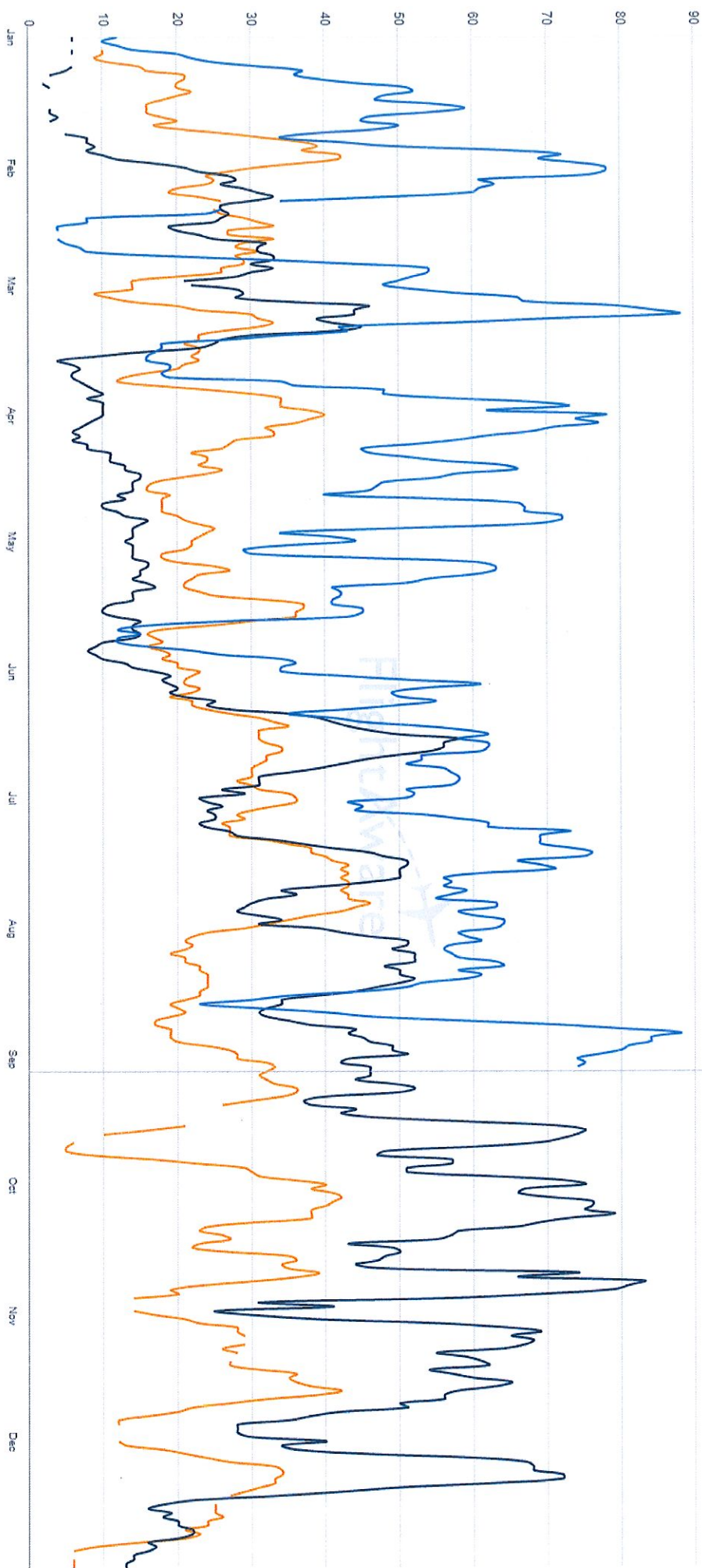

Project status - ALP Upgrade Grant has been Awarded

-Anticipate the Frequency change to 123.05 mhz to occur Oct 1, 2021

Update – Frequency Change has been accepted and approved by the FAA.

-We were awarded the Tourism Grant to help pay for fuel for a
Candy Bomber Event/Airshow.

- Increase in Jet traffic results in an increase in all of our ramp fees and also in the amount of aircraft we have to move around almost on a daily basis. We also are attempting to perform more training on movement of aircraft properly.

- We have or are in the process of installing beacon lights and or safety flags on all of our equipment. We will also be requiring ALL vehicles that operate on the movement area's to have either Rotating Beacons or Safety flags AND a radio while moving on the ramp/Taxi way and ALL movement areas. We will also require training /Authorization from the Airport Director Or Operations Supervisor prior to their operating a moving vehicle on the Airport grounds due to the vast numbers of vehicular traffic in the movement areas; including in and around and even in between aircraft.

- We have daily communication from interested parties that would like to station or be based out of Durant Regional Airport. This is very exciting to see the potential growth that is coming here. Lisa Taylor (DIA/ED) is actively working with these potential partners.

- We have also implemented Situational Awareness training due to the Terror Threat Alerts related to September 11, 2001

Incidents

- We had a minor incident at the airport on 8/21/2021. An aircraft wing was slightly damaged after hitting the side of a hangar. All information has been gathered and sent up to appropriate parties.

Hours of operation are 0700-1900 7 days a week and we are asked to fuel before or after our schedule times often. On Call 24 hours
