RESOLUTION NO. 2023-07

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION FOR PROJECT QUALIFYING FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021; COMMITMENT TO MUNICIPAL PARTICIPATION

WHEREAS, The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) provides certain funds in the form of grants to communities for qualifying projects; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Durant has identified a project believed to qualify for ARPA funding – specifically, improvements to the City’s water delivery system; and,

WHEREAS, the identified project would benefit the citizens of the City of Durant and the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma by making improvements to critical infrastructure associated with the City’s water system thereby markedly enhancing the City’s ability to reliably deliver clean water to its customers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Durant City Council that;

Section 1: City staff is authorized to take required steps to apply for or otherwise obtain grant funds through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

Section 2: The Council recognizes that ARPA funding may be contingent on certain funding matches by the City in the form of cash, in-kind contributions, or both and the City is committed to such matching efforts.
